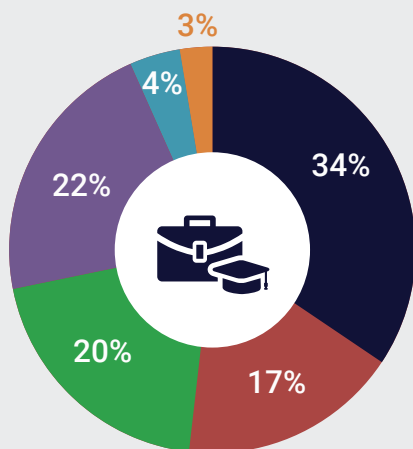

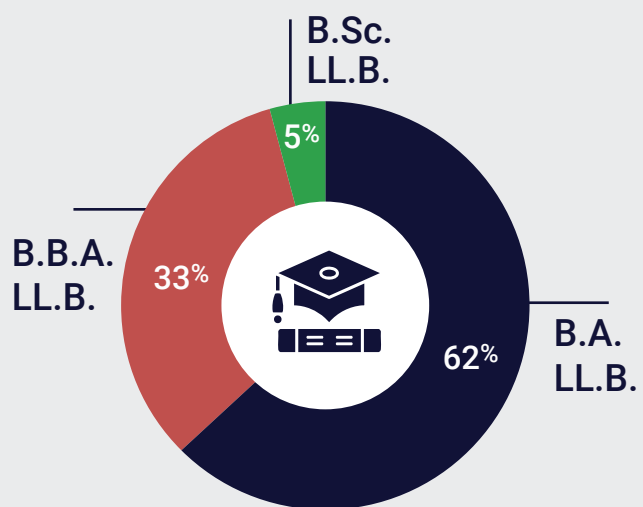

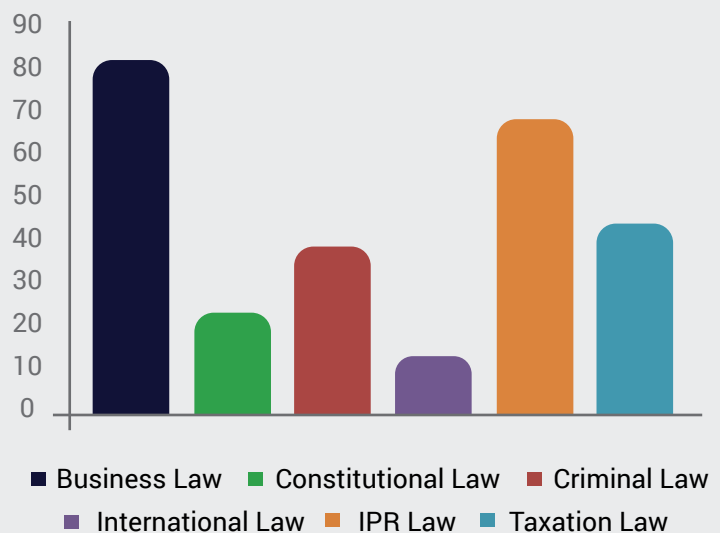

Internship & Placement Program

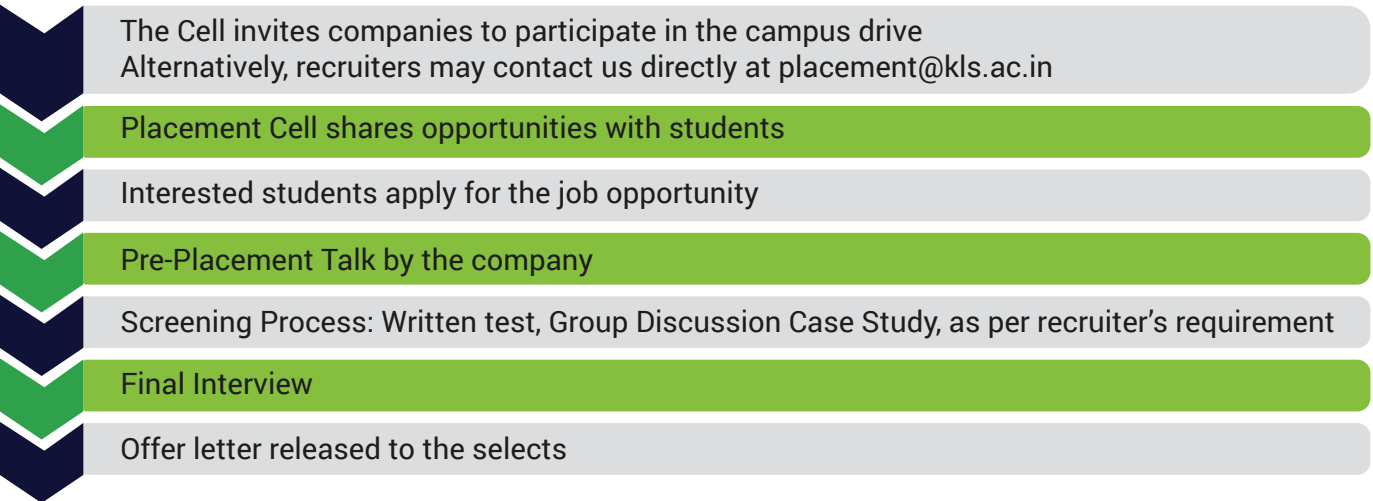

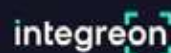
